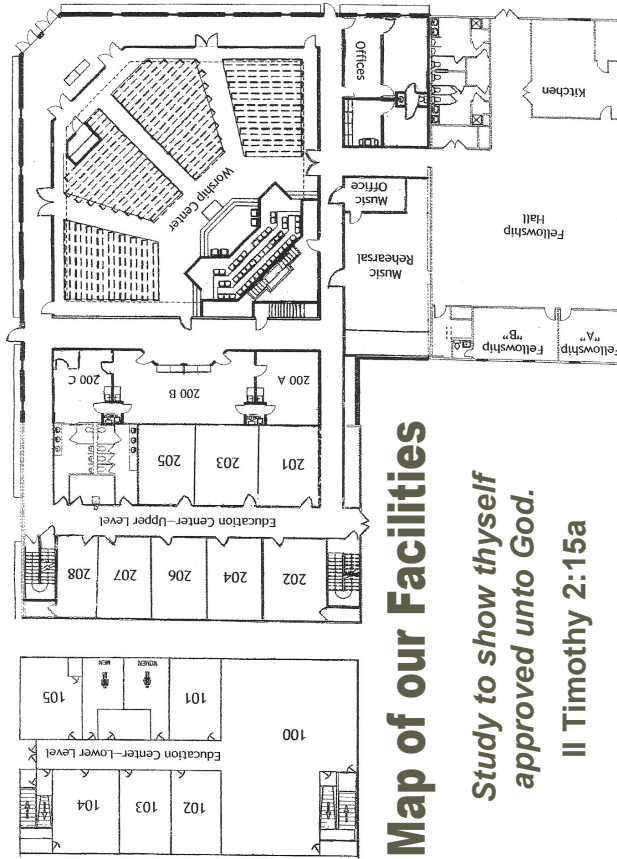

LIVING IN THE REAL WORLD

What is real? That question is harder for people to answer now than perhaps ever before. The line between real and fiction is blurred in many people's minds. They are so used to living a lie that it has become their reality.

The greatest threat to our faith is not persecution but distraction; not hatred of God but forgetfulness of Him. We are being formed every day by what we attend to, and if we are not intentional, we will wake up fluent in the language of a kingdom we never chose.

The God of heaven still speaks, but He will not compete with noise, and He will not shout over idols we refuse to silence. Today is not a call to log out, but to bow down—to lay our attention, our appetites, and our affections back on the altar. Choose carefully who gets your gaze, because the voice you listen to will become the life you live.

Some believers have adopted this approach to life. They have turned their spiritual lives into a display. Their personas are more important than their hearts, and their reputations are more important than their relationships with God.

Living in the Real World will encourage learners to honestly examine their lives in light of God's Word. It will confront them with the need to live according to Biblical realities. It will emphasize how the truth about God, the Bible, Christ, the Holy Spirit, the church, and future reward and judgment should shape and direct

their lives.

Believers who live in the real world will produce real fruit. Their lives will be useful to God and will bear everlasting results. Believers who ignore Biblical realities are living a lie and wasting their lives. Their fruit, like the digital avatar, is just for show; it has no real value.

This course will confront learners with Biblical realities and challenge them to examine their lives in light of those realities. And it will encourage them to approach life with honesty and with a desire to grow.

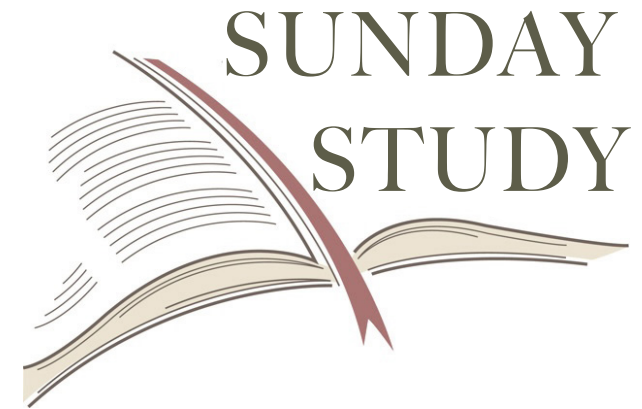
Messianic Christology

This course explores Messianic Christology—the study of Old Testament prophecies fulfilled in the first coming of the Messiah. Presented from a Messianic Jewish perspective, we will examine how these prophecies are fulfilled in the life of Jesus (Yeshua) through the three divisions of the Hebrew Scriptures: the Law, the Prophets, and the Writings. We will also consider how Jesus and His disciples addressed these prophecies in the New Testament. The course includes a special Passover study highlighting its fulfillment in Jesus and focuses on the written Torah rather than the oral law.
