



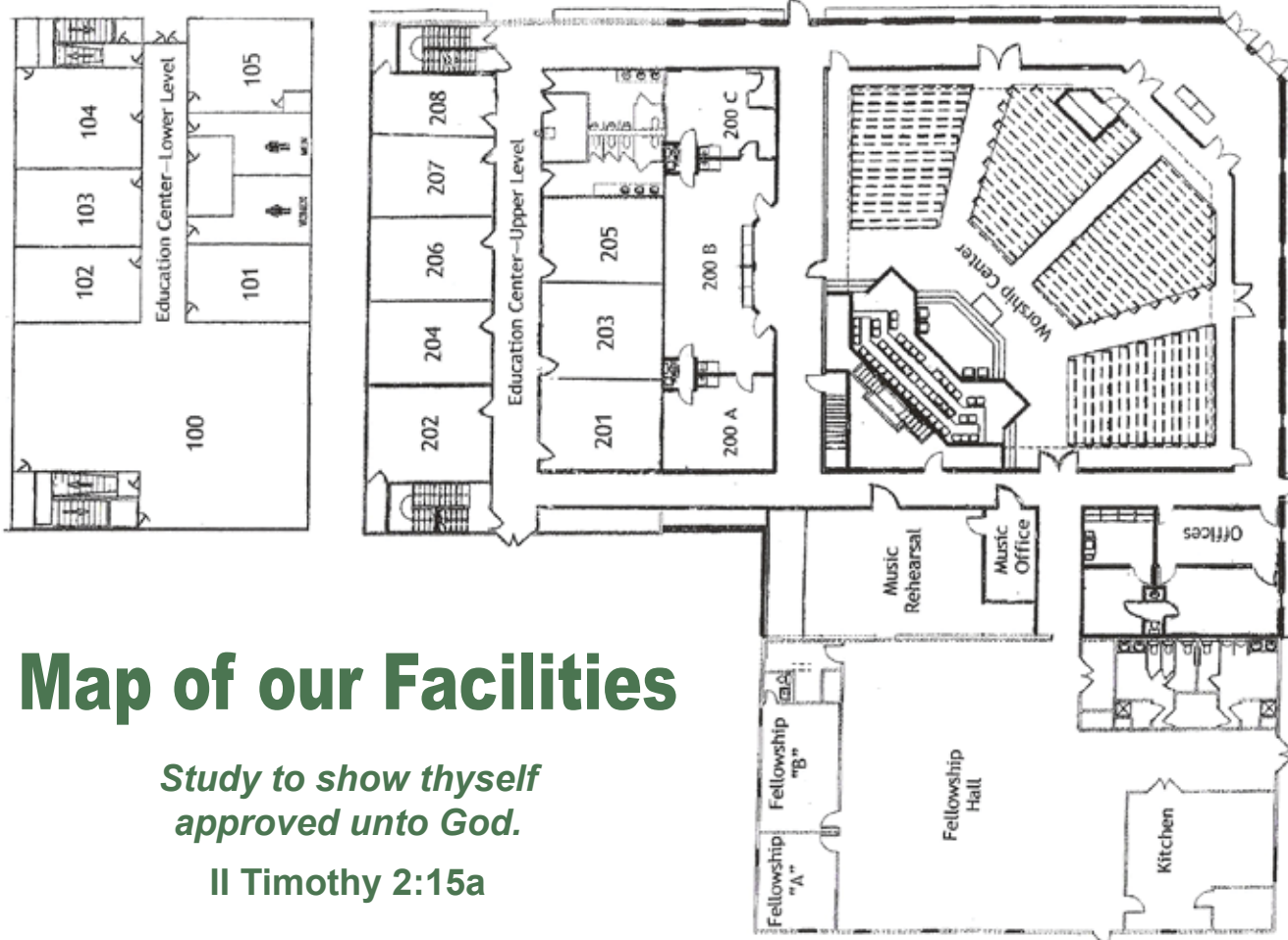

God’s Word never becomes irrelevant because God never becomes irrelevant. We can study His interaction with His people and the ancient nations of the world as recorded in the Minor Prophets and gain a greater understanding of Him. What we learn about God can be transforming since the God of the prophets is the same faithful God we serve today. We call the last twelve books of the Old Testament the Minor Prophets, not because they are unimportant but because they are shorter in length than Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and Daniel. This quarter we will study the last six of these twelve prophets who focus on the end of the kingdom of Judah and the post-exilic Jews.
