



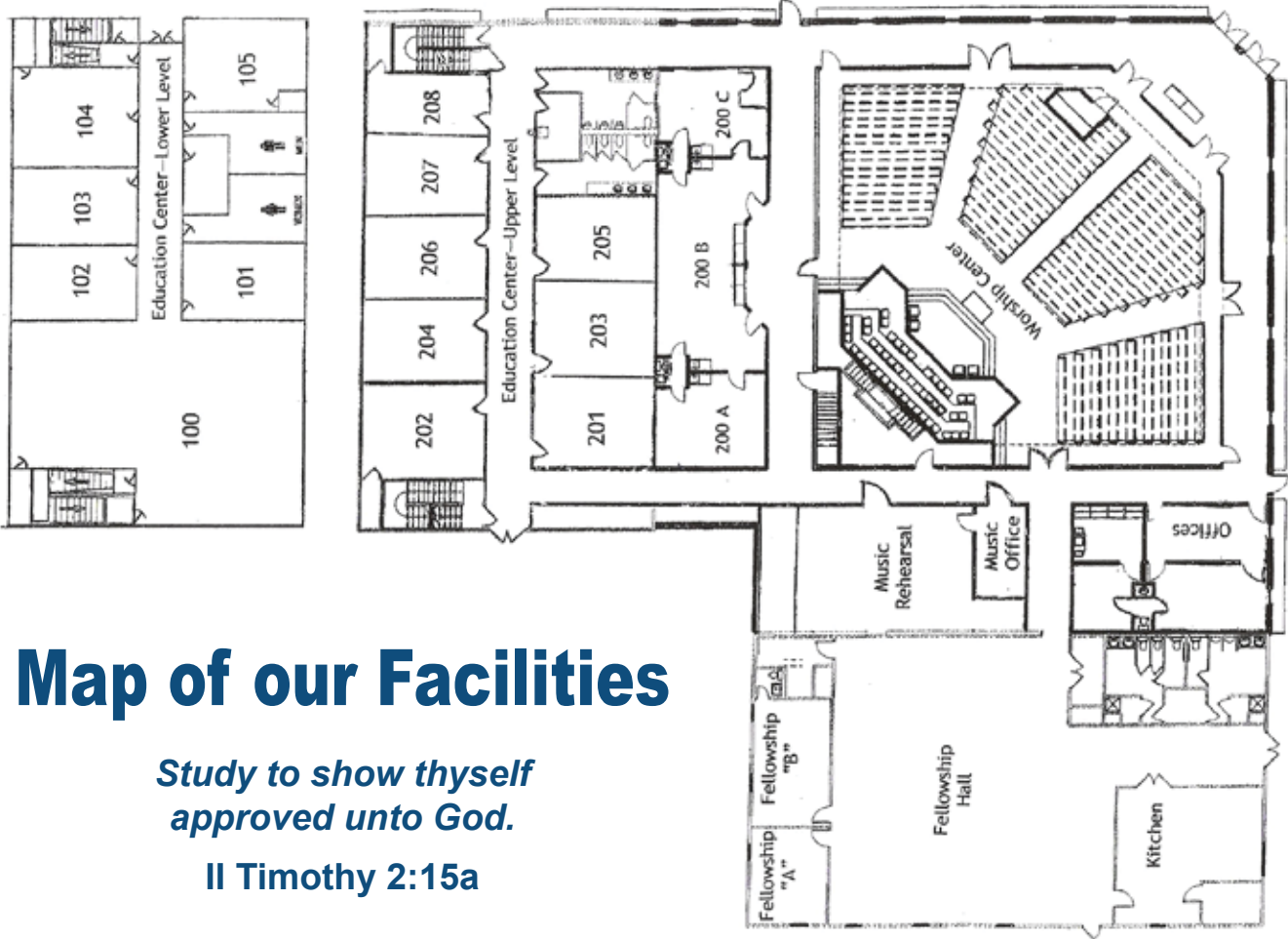

Theology: it may sound fancy or even intimidating, but it impacts everyone. Theology is simply the study of the nature of God. Everyone believes something about God - from the most scholarly seminary student to the atheist whose belief about God is that He does not exist. You may not realize it, but your theology has a profound impact on your daily life. The question is does your theology match what God has revealed about Himself? Is what you believe about God actually true? And if it is, so what? How does the truth about God transform the way you live your life? In this class geared towards college and career-aged students, we will explore core principles of theology such as the trustworthiness of the Bible, the nature of our triune God, and the nature of humanity and the church. As we explore these topics we will seek to discover how these truths about God collide with the nitty-gritty, real-life issues we face every day.

The twelve prophets delivered God's messages about pride, envy, hypocritical worship, and exploiting the poor. They demonstrated how nations rise and fall according to God's will. And God spoke through them to reveal His plans. Some of those plans have been accomplished and are now passed from our perspective, but others are still forthcoming. The fulfilled prophecies reinforce our confidence that God will literally fulfill the remaining prophecies. We call the last twelve books of the Old Testament the Minor Prophets, not because they are unimportant but because they are shorter in length than Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, and Daniel. This is a two-quarter study of these twelve prophets.
